WAITING FOR THE CITIZENS

Putting the figure of Machiavelli in the contemporary context of a crisis of democracy in Europe, the play debates the importance of citizen assemblies. It explores the different facets of Machiavelli, his own contradictions, and the relationship between people and power.

For Eucrazia, president of the EU Commission, this day begins like any other, with speeches, meetings and conspirations. But this time around, one theme seems to be on everyone's mind: citizens' assemblies. Should Europeans use them more widely? Should they become a permanent fixture of EU democracy? Are they a simple box to tick or the next democratic revolution? Technocrats, populists, academics, all want their say. As the action is taking place in Salone dei Cinquecento, it is no surprise that Machiavelli volunteers to nudge our characters. They will not be the only one to decide however as the audience is invited to join in on what is everything but a straightforward question.
